| <b>1 Hoyle Mill,<br/>Pontefract Road<br/>S71 1HR</b><br><b>2 Mill of the Black<br/>Monk, Grange Lane<br/>S71 5QF</b>           | <p>1 Meet in the public car park and walk to Barnsley. This walk is flat with good footpaths – visit café and return by a different path</p> <p>2 Meet in the public car park opposite the Mill of the Black Monk – walk to Stairfoot – Good footpaths– visit café at Stairfoot and return by a different route<br/>These two walks are on the same trail but each walk is in the opposite direction.</p>  |
| <b>Newmillerdam<br/>WF2 6QQ*</b><br><b>Easy walk</b>   | <p>Situated on the A61 from Barnsley, park in the public car park which is situated on the right hand side at the bottom of the hill. Now a charge for parking.<br/>Refreshments by kind invitation of Dianne or in the café by the side of the lake.</p>  |
| <b>Elsecar* S74 8EP</b><br><b>Some inclines on<br/>some of the walks</b><br><br><b>Elsecar from<br/>Cortonwood S73<br/>0SX</b> | <p>Meet in the Heritage car park opposite Elsecar Park. From Barnsley A61 and then on the new road system at Birdwell, take the A6135 lane to Hoyland Common. At the cross roads take the left hand turn and travel to Hoyland taking the right hand fork. Go through Hoyland and down the hill to Elsecar. At the bottom turn right to the car park which is on the left<br/>Meet in the car park in front of Morrisons, Cortonwood – walk along the canal to Elsecar, visit café and return on same route</p>                                      |
| <b>Manvers* /Old<br/>Moor S73 0YF</b> <b>Easy<br/>walk</b>   | <p>Meet in the car park at the Old Moor Nature Reserve (RSPB) – no charge for parking. On the A6195 at the Broomhill roundabout take the A633 turn and follow the brown signs for the nature reserve which is on the left hand side</p>  |
| <b>Low Bradfield<br/>S6 6HW</b> <b>Easy walk</b>   | <p>Various routes. <b>Meet in the Village Car Park behind cricket field, N.B. the post code is a general for the village</b></p>   |
| <b>1 Worsbrough Mill*<br/>S70 5LJ</b> <b>Easy walk</b><br><b>2 Kendal Green</b>  | <p>1 A61 between Barnsley and Birdwell. Park in the official car park for Worsbrough Mill. On the right from Barnsley and left from Birdwell. A small charge for parking<br/>2 On A61 turn at the Ship Inn and follow signs to Wigfield Farm – Car park is on left just past farm</p>  |
| <b>Cannon Hall<br/>/Cawthorne* S75<br/>4AR</b>   | <p>Meet in the garden centre car park (just over the bridge and on the left). A small charge is made for parking but can be refunded in the café or shop. Meet in the car park. Some inclines.</p>   |
| <b>Scout Dike S36 7GF</b><br><b>Mostly flat</b>  | <p>A628 from Barnsley Manchester Road. At roundabout take A629 Huddersfield road. After approx 2 miles look for Activity Centre on right – park opposite on left</p>   |
| <b>1 Wentworth* S62<br/>7TF</b><br><b>2 Easy walk<br/>Longer Walk</b>  | <p>1 Meet in the village car park or garden centre – no charge for parking – location will be notified prior to the walk.<br/>2 Meet in the car park near to the house (Wentworth Woodhouse) or the village car park to be arranged nearer the time. The walk to be decided nearer the time</p>  |
| <b>Locke Park,<br/>Barnsley* S70 6NF</b><br><b>Easy walk with<br/>some inclines</b>  | <p>Meet at the main car park – free to park. From Birdwell travel on A61 towards Barnsley downhill towards Worsbrough. Go over old railway line (now TPTrail) and take left fork at Ship Inn. Travel up hill, at cross roads take left turn, keep on this road passing Rob Royd Farm shop – Locke Park car park is on right hand bend. If travelling from Barnsley take A61 south, at cross roads and traffic lights take right hand turn, at next cross roads go straight over passing the Rob Royd Farm shop – car park is on right hand bend.</p> |
| <b>Five Weirs Walk<br/>Easy walk<br/>( M'Hall - S9 1EP)</b>  | <p>Meet outside M&amp;S Meadowhall – downstairs. Take care with parking as tickets sometimes given to non-shoppers. Walk along canal so far and then calling in at Starbucks for refreshments and then back to Meadowhall.</p>   |
| <b>Rabbit Ings/ S71<br/>4BB</b>  | <p>Use sav nav for this location as many roads lead to Rabbit Ings. Refreshments a short distance away. This is an easy walk with some inclines.</p>   |
| <b>Pugneys WF2 7EQ</b><br><b>Easy walk</b>   | <p>Junction 39 M1 – Wakefield Road – turn right at roundabout signed for Pugneys or A61 passed Newmillerdam at traffic lights sharp left – go past Asda and turn right at roundabout, follow brown signs</p>   |
| <b>Cudworth S72 8UQ</b>  | <p>Meet in one of the car parks on the main shopping street in Cudworth opposite the Co-op.</p>  |
| <b>Anglers Country<br/>Park WF4 2EE</b>  | <p>The sav nav for this area is misleading. One route is on A61 and turn off to right signposted Notton. Several other routes to Anglers Country Park, Haw Park Lane, Wakefield – follow the signs.</p>  |
