Pugneys *WF2 7EQ Easy walk	Junct 39 M1 – Wakefield Road – turn right at roundabout or A61 passed Newmillerdam at traffic lights sharp left – go past Asda and turn right at roundabout – follow brown signs
Newmillerdam WF2 6QQ*	Meet in the public car park on the right hand side. First 2 hours free but you must obtain a ticket. An easy walk
Langsett S36 4GY Some inclines	From Birdwell take the A61 and then A616 Stocksbridge bypass. At about 7 miles and when you see the café with the red spots the car park to Langsett is on the left hand side (signed). From Barnsley A628 then A616 and car park is on the right hand side only a short distance from the junction
Elsecar* S74 8EP Some inclines on some of the walks	Meet in the Heritage Car park opposite Elsecar Park. From Barnsley A61 and then on the new road system at Birdwell, take the A6135 lane to Hoyland Common. At the cross roads take the left hand turn and travel to Hoyland taking the right hand fork. Go through Hoyland and down the hill to Elsecar. At the bottom turn right to the car park which is on the left
Manvers* /Old Moor S73 0YF Easy walk	Meet in the car park at the Old Moor Nature Reserve (RSPB) – no charge for parking. On the A6195 at the Broomhill Roundabout take the A633 turn and follow the brown signs for the nature reserve which is on the left hand side
Low Bradfield S6 6HW Easy walk	Various routes . Meet in the Village Car Park, N.B. the post code is a general for the village
Worsbrough Mill* S70 5LJ Easy walk	A61 between Barnsley and Birdwell. Park in the official car park for Worsbrough Mill. On the right from Barnsley and left from Birdwell. A small charge for parking
Cannon Hall /Cawthorne* S75 4AR Some inclines	Meet in the garden centre car park (just over the bridge and on the left). A small charge is made for parking but can be refunded in the café or shop. Meet in the car park
Scout Dyke S36 7GF Mostly flat	A628 from Barnsley Manchester Road. At roundabout take A629 Huddersfield road. After approx 2 miles look for Scout Dyke Centre on right – park opposite on left hand side at reservoir.
Wentworth* S62 7TF Easy walk	Meet at the garden centre car park. Park to the right of the main gates and meet at the entrance to the car park – no charge for parking
Longer Walk To take approximately one hour	Meet in the car park near to the house (Wentworth Woodhouse). Walk usually towards the lakes but may vary according to the weather.
Locke Park, Barnsley* S70 6NF Easy walk with some inclines	Meet at the main car park – free to park. From Birdwell travel on A61 towards Barnsley downhill towards Worsbrough. Go over old railway line (now TPTrail) and take left fork at Ship Inn. Travel up hill, at cross roads take left turn, keep on this road passing Rob Royd Farm shop – Locke Park car park is on right hand bend. If travelling from Barnsley take A61 south, at cross roads and traffic lights take right hand turn, at next cross roads go straight over passing the Rob Royd Farm shop – car park is on right hand bend.
Five Weirs Walk Easy walk (M'Hall - S9 1EP)	Meet outside M&S Meadowhall – downstairs. Take care with parking as tickets are being given to non-shoppers. We usually stop at Starbucks half way round for refreshments. .
Rabbit Ings/ S71 4BB Easy walk with some inclines	Take A61 from Barnsley and at Staincross take the right hand turn (B6428) at the cross roads onto Lee Lane. Keep on B6428 travelling through Royston under the railway bridge (Lund Hill Lane) as you start to climb up the hill the Rabbit Ings car park is on the right - plenty of spaces. Refreshments at Poppys café in Cudworth.
Cudworth/Cudworth Park S72 8UQ	From Lundwood/Monk Bretton take road through village – not bypass. Park in one of 2 car parks on the left. One opposite StarHotel. 2 nd next turning on left before Well chemist. Both car parks join. No charge for parking. Refreshments in Poppys café opposite the car parks.
