Pugneys WF2 7EQ Easy walk	Junction 39 M1 – Wakefield Road – turn right at roundabout or A61 past Newmillerdam at traffic lights, sharp left turn – go past Asda and turn right at roundabout follow brown signs. Free parking for 2 hours then small charge.
Langsett Some inclines S36 4GY	From Birdwell take the A61 and then A616 Stocksbridge bypass. At about 7 miles and when you see the café with the red spots, the car park to Langsett is on the left hand side (signed). From Barnsley A628 then A616 and the car park is on the right hand side only a short distance from the junction.
Elsecar S74 8EP Some inclines on some of the walks	Meet in the Heritage Car park opposite Elsecar Park – no charge for parking. From Barnsley A61 and then on the new road system at Birdwell, take the A6135 lane to Hoyland Common. At the cross road take the left hand turn and travel to Hoyland taking the right hand fork. Go through Hoyland down the hill to Elsecar. At the bottom turn right to the car park which is on the left.
Manvers RSPB Easy walk S73 0YF	Meet in the car park at the Old Moor Nature Reserve (RSPB) – no charge for parking. On the A6195 at the Broomhill roundabout take the A633 turn and follow the brown signs for the nature reserve which is on the left hand side.
Worsbrough Mill S70 5LJ Easy walk	A61 between Barnsley and Birdwell. Park in the official car park for Worsborough Mill – small charge for parking. On the right from Barnsley and left from Birdwell.
Wentworth Woodhouse S62 7TQ Some inclines	Park in the main car park in the grounds of the house – no charge for parking. Various routes
Locke Park, Barnsley Easy walk with some inclines S70 6NF	Meet in the main car park – no charge for parking. From Birdwell travel on A61 towards Barnsley downhill towards Worsbrough. Go over old railway line (now TPT) and take left fork at Ship Inn (now derelict). Travel up hill, at cross roads take left turn, keep on this road passing Rob Royd Farm shop and café – Locke Park car park is on right hand bend. If travelling from Barnsley take A61 south, at cross roads and traffic lights turn right, at next cross roads go straight over passing Rob Royd Farm shop and café – car park is on right hand bend.
5weirs Meadowhall (M.Hall) S9 1EP Easy walk	Meet outside M&S Meadowhall – downstairs. Take care with parking as sometimes tickets are given to non-shoppers.
Rabbit Ings, Royston S71 4BB Easy walk with some inclines	Take A61 from Barnsley and at Staincross take the right hand turn B6428 at the cross roads onto Lee Lane. Keep on this road travelling through Royston and under the railway bridge (Lund Hill Lane). As you start to climb up the hill the Rabbit Ings car park is on the right – plenty of spaces and no charge for parking.
Kendal Green (TPT) Some inclines	This is a new walk. Follow the initial directions to Locke Park – at Ship Inn turn immediate left and follow road to Wigfield Farm. Just beyond Wigfield Farm is a park on the right hand side called Kendal Green. Only a few parking spaces available but will have enough spaces for walking group.
