Directions and locations of walks Post codes /Sat Nav for guidance only

Hoyle Mill, Pontefract Rd	Meet in the public car park and walk to Barnsley. This walk is flat with good footpaths – visit café and return by a different path S71 1HR
Mill of the Black Monk, Grange Lane	Meet in the public car park opposite the Mill of the Black Monk – walk to Stairfoot – Good footpaths with a slight incline at the beginning – visit café at Stairfoot and return by a different route. S71 5QF
Newmillerdam WF2 6QQ* Easy walk	Situated on the A61 from Barnsley, park in the public car park which is situated on the right side at the bottom of the hill. Now a charge for parking. Refreshments by kind invitation of Dianne or in the café by the side of the lake.
Langsett S36 4GY Some inclines	From Birdwell take the A61 and then A616 Stocksbridge bypass. At about 7 miles and when you see the café with the red spots on the right the car park to Langsett is on the left (signed). From Barnsley A628 then A616 and car park is on the right, only a short distance from the junction
Elsecar* S74 8EP Some inclines Cortonwood S73 0SX	Meet in the Heritage car park opposite Elsecar Park. From Barnsley A61 and at Birdwell take the A6135 lane to Hoyland Common. At the cross roads take the left turn, travel to Hoyland taking the right fork and down the hill to Elsecar. At the bottom turn right, car park which is on the left Meet in the car park in front of Morrisons, Cortonwood – walk along the canal to Elsecar, visit café and return on same route
Manvers* /Old Moor S73 0YF Easy walk	Meet in the car park at the Old Moor Nature Reserve (RSPB). On the A6195 at the Broomhill roundabout take the A633 turn and follow the brown signs for the nature reserve which is on the left.
Nostell Priory, Wragby WF4 1QE	Follow the directions on your satnav. Directions will vary depending on your starting point. This is a National Trust area and for those who are members parking is free. Car share if possible.
Low Bradfield S6 6HW Easy walk	Various routes. Meet in the Village Car Park behind cricket field. PLEASE NOTE: the post code is a general for the village
Worsbrough Mill* S70 5LJ Easy walk	A61 between Barnsley and Birdwell. Park in the official car park for Worsbrough Mill. On the right from Barnsley and left from Birdwell. A small charge for parking
Kendal Green/Worsbrough	On A61 turn at the Ship Inn and follow signs to Wigfield Farm – Car park (free) is just past farm
Cannon Hall /Cawthorne*	Meet in the garden centre car park (just over the bridge and on the left). A small charge is made for parking but can be refunded in the café or shop. Meet in the car park. Some inclines. S75 4AR
Scout Dike S36 7GF Mostly flat	A628 from Barnsley Manchester Road. At roundabout take A629 Huddersfield road. After approx 2 miles look for Scout Dike Centre on right – park opposite on left hand side at reservoir.
Wentworth* S62 7TF Easy walk	Meet in the village car park or garden centre –location will be notified prior to the walk.
Wentworth Longer Walk	Meet in the car park near to the house (Wentworth Woodhouse) or the village car park to be arranged nearer the time. The walk will be from the house towards Greasborough or around the village.
Locke Park, Barnsley* S70 6NF Easy walk with some inclines	Meet at the main car park – free to park. From Birdwell travel on A61 towards Barnsley downhill towards Worsbrough. Go over old railway line (now TPTrail) and take left fork at Ship Inn. Travel up hill, at cross roads take left turn, keep on this road passing Rob Royd Farm shop – Locke Park car park is on right hand bend. If travelling from Barnsley take A61 south, at cross roads and traffic lights take right turn, at next cross roads go straight over passing the Rob Royd Farm shop – car park is on right.
Five Weirs Walk Easy walk (M'Hall - S9 1EP)	Meet outside M&S Meadowhall – downstairs. Take care with parking as tickets are being given to non-shoppers
Rabbit Ings/ S71 4BB Easy walk with some inclines	Take A61 from Barnsley and at Staincross take the right turn (B6428) at the cross roads onto Lee Lane. Keep on B6428 travelling through Royston under the railway bridge (Lund Hill Lane) the Rabbit Ings car park is on the right. Refreshments a short distance away.
Pugneys WF2 7EQ Easy walk	Junction 39 M1 – Wakefield Road – turn right at roundabout signed for Pugneys or A61 passed Newmillerdam at traffic lights sharp left – go past Asda and turn right at roundabout, follow brown signs
Cudworth/Cudworth Country Park	Meet in one of the car parks on the main shopping street in Cudworth, turn down the side street by Well Pharmacy opposite the co-op.
Anglers Country Park WF4 2EE Easy walk	Anglers Country Park is on Haw Park Lane, Wakefield. There are various ways of getting there and the satnav covers a wide area. So, check your map directions, road signs now much improved.
Wortley Hall and beyond S35 7DB Easy walk with some inclines	At the sharp bend in the road at Wortley and opposite the church turn and go through the gates on the left. Go down the long drive and park either in front of the hall or turn right just before the hall and park at the back.
